- Event Dates:
 - Semi-Final Performances: July 19 – 20 and 22 - 23, 2019
 - Gold Medal Round: July 24, 2019
- Performance Times: 8:00 PM MDT each night
- Arena Location:
 - Days of '47 Arena
 - Utah State Fairpark
 - 300 North, 1200 West
 - Salt Lake City, Utah 84116
- Disciplines: Bareback Riding, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping-Header, Team Roping-Heeler, Saddle Bronc Riding, Women's Breakaway Roping, Tie-Down Roping, Barrel Racing, Bull Riding
- Contestant Check-in: Must check in with Event Rodeo Secretary by 5:00 PM day of scheduled performance. Check-in will be open from 3PM – 5PM.
- Autographs: Each contestant is required to sign autographs for 30 minutes between 7:00 PM and 7:30 PM on the night(s) competing. Location of autographs is the big Lewis Feild bronze statue on the southeast corner of the arena.
- Procedure to Compete:
 - Entries will be open to anyone, however entries will be validated based on the qualification parameters listed on the chart at the end. Any entries other than those individuals will be placed on an alternate list. Entries will be taken through the WCRA app and will include a DO47CGR Contestant Agreement which athlete will be required to complete and digitally sign. To enter, athlete must be registered as a user in the WCRA Virtual Rodeo Qualifier (VRQ). No membership dues or fees are required to register. To register, go to www.wcrarodeo.com or click [HERE](#)
 - **If you sign a Contestant Agreement, agreeing to attend and compete and do not, you will not be eligible this event or any other Days of '47 Rodeo event for two years.**
 - **ENTRIES OPEN MONDAY, JULY 1, 2019, 8:00 AM MDT. ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY, JULY 10, 2019, 5:00 PM MDT**
 - When entering, you will be able to give a 1st preference, 2nd preference, and 3rd preference.
 - First to enter gets first priority (*qualified athletes will receive priority preference ahead of any alternates)
 - List of confirmed Headers and Heelers entered will be sent out the morning of Thursday, July 11th – deadline to declare partners is Thursday, July 11th at 5:00 PM MDT
 - Call Backs: Contestants will receive an email/text the evening of Friday, July 12, 2019, stating their scheduled performance.
 - First Go Trades: Trades will be allowed in the Semi-Final performances. All trades must be called in and verified by the Event Rodeo Secretary before 5:00 PM MDT Monday, July 15, 2019.
- Fees to Compete = \$0
- Sanctioning: The rodeo is not currently sanctioned by anyone other than the PBR (bull riding).

- Notes for Team Ropers:
 - Headers and Heelers are qualified separately. The 32 entered and qualified headers must rope with the 32 entered and qualified heelers.
 - You may qualify only once as a header and once as a heeler.
- Notes for Bull Riders:
 - Bull riders will earn PBR points toward the 2019 PBR World Standings. Velocity Tour points criteria will be used.
 - **FOR PBR POINTS ONLY:** All the Semi-Final Performances combined will be considered one whole round. Semi-Final Round Points: 1st = 50; 2nd = 25; 3rd = 10. PBR does not give points for short round performances so the gold medal round will not get points, however aggregate points are awarded based off of the final positioning in the event: Aggregate Points: 1st = 170; 2nd = 90; 3rd = 55; 4th = 20; 5th = 15; 6th = 10; 7th = 5)
 - All bull riders must be a current member of the PBR and must be registered with the WCRA in order to compete.

FORMAT

- Four (4) Semi-Final performances and one (1) Gold Medal Round. 32 contestants will be qualified to compete in each discipline. The Semi-Finals will consist of four (4) separate performances with eight (8) contestants in each discipline of each performance. The two (2) highest scores/fastest times from each discipline of each performance will advance to the Gold Medal Round along with the two (2) highest scores/fastest times overall, from all four combined Semi-Final performances that have not yet advanced, for a total of ten (10) contestants in each discipline. Scores/times will NOT carry forward to the Gold Medal Round (only to break ties). For complete rules, refer to the DO47CGR Contestant Agreement, Ground Rules and Competition Rules.
- Order of events are tentatively schedule as, but subject to change: Bareback Riding, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping, Saddle Bronc Riding, Intermission, Women's Breakaway Roping, Tie-Down Roping, Barrel Racing, Bull Riding

PAYOUT (TOTAL OF \$125,000 PER DISCIPLINE [\$125,000 FOR HEADERS & \$125,000 FOR HEELERS])

- Each Semi-Final Performance:
 - 1st = \$3,200 (per man)
 - 2nd = \$2,400 (per man)
 - 3rd = \$1,600 (per man)
 - 4th = \$ 800 (per man)
- Gold Medal Round:
 - 1st = \$50,000 plus a Gold Medal (per man)
 - 2nd = \$25,000 plus a Silver Medal (per man)
 - 3rd = \$12,000 plus a Bronze Medal (per man)
 - 4th = \$ 6,000 (per man)
